



Quick Guide: 5-Minute Stove Glass Cleaning Method

Step 1: Cool Completely

Make sure your stove is fully cold before cleaning. Never clean hot glass – it can crack.

Step 2: Prepare Ash Cleaner

Take a damp cloth or piece of kitchen roll. Dip it into the fine ash from your stove. Ash is mildly abrasive and perfect for lifting soot.

Step 3: Wipe in Circles

Gently rub the glass in small circles. Focus on soot marks and blackened areas.

Step 4: Buff Clean

Use a fresh, dry cloth to buff the glass. Enjoy a streak-free, clear view of your fire.

Quick Tips

- Only use seasoned or kiln-dried logs – damp wood causes black glass.
- Keep the airwash vent open when lighting your stove.
- Sweep your chimney regularly for cleaner, safer burning.
